



## Art Curriculum Overview - Year 11

	Unit	Details
Autumn One	<b>3D Project</b>	Taking inspiration from sculptors and craftspeople, pupils will design, plan and create a 3-Dimensional artwork. This will include initial sketches, material studies, maquettes and prototypes along with their final design. This will increase their understanding of craft techniques while allowing for flexibility of design. Pupils will have a choice of materials, which could include paper, wire, air dry clay, textiles.
Autumn Two	<b>Final Piece</b>	Pupils will plan for and produce a final artwork, this will be on a large scale and should present the culmination of complex, layered ideas, materials and techniques. This should relate to their theme and their creative journey throughout their coursework.
Spring One	<b>Externally Set Assignment</b>	Pupils will receive a theme set by the exam board, they will then work on preparatory studies up until their exam. This will include developing concepts based on their theme and exploring these using a range of techniques, materials and processes. This will culminate in their final exam, for which they will have 10 hours to create an ambitious and creative final piece.
