



French Curriculum Overview - Year 10

	Unit	Details
Autumn One	Life at school/college	Pupils will build on knowledge acquired in Year 9's sub-topic of My Studies in the theme of current and future study and employment to discuss school uniform, school rules, problems at schools and what their ideal school would be like. Pupils will complete a GCSE-style writing task on this topic to showcase their knowledge of key vocabulary and structures as well as verbs in the past, present and future tense.
Autumn Two	Education post-16	Pupils continue to deepen their knowledge of the theme of current and future study and employment by describing their future plans with regards to A-level and university study as well as potential careers. Pupils will look to incorporate some more complex structures into their work, including relative pronouns <i>ce qui</i> and <i>ce que</i> as well as <i>si</i> clauses.
Spring One	Travel and Tourism	Pupils will build on knowledge of holidays acquired in Year 8 to discuss where they usually go on holiday as well as giving more detailed accounts about past holiday experiences and memories. Pupils will review the Perfect and Imperfect tenses and also consolidate techniques regarding responding effectively to GCSE Photo Card tasks.
Spring Two	Healthy / Unhealthy living	Pupils will expand on prior learning of food & drink in Year 8, to be able to discuss both current and previous eating and exercise habits in greater detail. They will also express and justify viewpoints towards tobacco, alcohol and drugs, as well as making future health resolutions. Pupils will also complete listening, reading and writing papers as part of Year 10 assessment week.
Summer One	Marriage/Partnership	Pupils will consolidate knowledge from the Year 9 topic Me, my family and friends to be able to describe what they look for in an ideal partner, their current attitudes towards marriage as well as their future relationship plans.
Summer Two	Technology in everyday life - Social Media / Mobile technology	Pupils will build on knowledge acquired at Key Stage 3 to explore the GCSE topic of Technology in everyday life with greater confidence. Pupils will also focus specifically on Role Play and Photo Card technique ahead of their end of Year 10 mock GCSE speaking assessment.
