



## Spanish Curriculum Overview - Year 10

	Unit	Details
Autumn One	<b>Travel and Tourism</b>	In this topic pupils will express & understand opinions regarding holiday preferences and weather. Pupils will learn key transactional language to find out more about facilities within different types of accommodation and express opinions. We will consolidate the preterite tense and contrast with the imperfect tense.
Autumn Two	<b>Customs and Festivals</b>	Pupils will develop cultural understanding of different hispanic festivals. They will describe a visit to a music festival. Pupils will also understand the differences between customs and traditions in Spain and the United Kingdom including Christmas.
Spring One	<b>Home and Local Area/Repaso</b>	In this topic pupils will learn how to describe where they live including buildings, facilities in the local area, what places were and will be like. They will consider the advantages and disadvantages of living in the city or countryside. Pupils will also focus on preparation for their Year 10 mock listening, reading and writing exams. This will involve vocabulary practice for all topics covered so far as well as revision of key grammatical structures.
Spring Two	<b>Mock Exam/Marriage and Relationships</b>	Pupils will complete mock exams in listening, reading and writing this half term. They will express future hopes regarding relationships and marriage and describe characteristics and physical attributes of others. We will consolidate use of the conditional tense.
Summer One	<b>Healthy and Unhealthy Lifestyles/Technology</b>	In this topic pupils will evaluate healthy and unhealthy lifestyles and give recommendations to others. They will describe past and current lifestyle choices. Pupils will describe what you do online; understand and describe the different uses of social media.
Summer Two	<b>Technology</b>	Pupils will learn how to discuss the benefits and dangers of mobile technology. Pupils will also focus on preparation for their mock speaking examination which will take place this half term. This will involve role-play, photo card and general conversation practice as well as revision of key grammatical structures.
