

Spanish Curriculum Overview - Year 11

	Unit	Details
Autumn One	Los temas globales	In this topic pupils will explore environmental issues and learn how to describe the environment in their region and actions they take to protect the environment and consider possible solutions. Pupils will also learn about other global issues such as poverty in the Spanish speaking world. Pupils will review key modal verbs in the present and conditional tense.
Autumn Two	Los temas globales y sociales	Pupils will continue to deepen their understanding of global issues and also explore key social issues such as homelessness and charity work. Pupils will also undertake key preparatory work for their mock speaking examination and other mock papers: listening; reading and writing.
Spring One	El mundo laboral	Following a detailed review of all mock papers, pupils will learn a range of structures to express their future ideas and understand those of others. They will consider the benefits and disadvantages of going to university and discuss the advantages and disadvantages of different jobs as well as the importance of learning a language. Pupils will draw on prior knowledge of adjectives and hobbies to consider why they may be suitable for certain types of work and also use this when writing a formal letter of application.
Spring Two	El mundo laboral /Repaso	Pupils continue to deepen their knowledge of the theme of careers and the world of work by describing their ideal job and explaining why it is relevant for them. Pupils will also focus on preparation for their GCSE speaking examination. This will involve role-play, photo card and general conversation practice as well as revision of key grammatical structures.
Summer One	Repaso	Lessons will be dedicated to the revision of key language, structures and exam skills in order to ensure pupils are thoroughly prepared for all components of the GCSE examinations.
